

### STREET KIDS FUNDS (SKF)

### **Annual Report-2020**

Street Kids Funds (SKF) is a registered 501c3 nonprofit organization based in California, USA. Tax ID # 82-1891756. SKF USA management consists of Board Members, Advisory Committee, Center Staff and Student Volunteers. SKF USA has 100% financial transparency on how funds are disbursed for the operational management of its projects and programs locally and internationally.

The mission of Street Kids Funds (SKF) is **NOT** to build schools! **BUT** to create learning centers for children with **NO** schooling living in slums and poor communities in developing countries. SKF's Learning Center project enrolls children ages 4 years to 12 years, provides free of cost primary level education and prepares them to successfully transition to mainstream public and private schools.

SKF USA has provided donation funds for educational grooming for under privileged street children in Pakistan since 2018. Between 30 to 40 children in 7 different groups (i.e., Play group, Nursey, and 1st to 5th level) based on their age and their learning ability have received basic primary level education. When a child successfully completes either 4th level or 5th level curriculum, they join SKF USA's "Raising Star Scholarship Program". Under the scholarship program 2 to 3 children each year transition into mainstream local public or private primary schools. The scholarship covers all the expenses at the school for the child i.e., admission fee, monthly school fees, school uniforms, books, stationary and any other expenses related to the school program, including pocket money for their daily snacks. Bi-annually progress review is conducted on each child in the scholarship program based on class attendance, overall achievement, and exam results at the school.

# STREET KIDS FUNDS (SKF) USA Activities in 2020

In 2020 SKF USA gave funds for 22 street children to get education in Pakistan. All the children were given new uniforms, schools bags, stationary and educational supplies. New colorful desks, floor carpet was also purchased for the children to sit during the religious learning class. New bright colorful wall decorations and posters were also added for the walls.

In 2020 SKF USA funded the education of 2 children into a mainstream public-school program in Pakistan, as part of "SKF USA *Raising Star Scholarship Program*". The two children successfully passed the selection process and got admission in a local FG Public School.





SKF USA fund helped children learn primary level basic English, Urdu, Math's, Science, and they also learnt to recite verses from the Quran in Arabic and having fun as well while learning.







As part of "Make Pakistan Green Initiative" children were taught how to create an organic garden planting vegetables and flowers.



In the beginning of November, it was announced that due to the sudden increase in COVID-19 cases around the world and in Pakistan, there was early winter break after the annual exams. With the help of SKF USA for all the children who had passed their final exams for 2020 they were given their report card envelopes by a guest specially invited to grace the occasion. Class trophies



were given to those children who secured top grades in their group and the rest of the children received medal. A fun musical event was organized for the children decorated with colorful balloons. The children performed songs and dances and had a fun time. Special lunch box treats were arranged for the children to eat as well.

### **SKF USA COVID-19 PROJECTS**

Coronavirus shutdown caused extreme hardships for poor families all around the world. People on daily wages such as house helpers and maids, cleaners, daily wage laborers, gardeners etc. lost their jobs. **Street Kids Funds USA Emergency Relief program** donates funds internationally and in USA in time of need.

### **SKF INTERNATIONAL PROJECT**

As part of the different relief programs organized during 2020 by SKF USA, COVID-19 "Food Distribution Program" was organized with the help of local volunteers in various cities in Pakistan during March – April. More than 300 deserving poor families in different cities in Pakistan affected financially due business closure and job loss received ration food boxes/bags and cash envelopes.



100 medical kits for front line health workers as part of SKF USA's COVID-19 "Medical Relief Program" was distributed in 3 hospitals in different cities in Pakistan.



All educational centers due to Covid-19 started to close in the different countries SKF USA distributed "Educational Kits" for street children that included homework sheets, writing copies, stationary, color pencils, color books and story books to read at home.







## **SKF USA COVID 19 Projects in USA**










## **SKF Financial Report for 2020**
