### **AUGUST**

Street Kids Funds (SKF) Multan Learning Center reopened in August after two and half months of the summer break. The **16 students** returned to their classrooms excited and full of energy to be back to continue their studies. The **18** other SKF's Rising Scholarship students studying in regular private and public schools also returned to their classes after the summer break.

On **August 19<sup>th</sup>**, **2024**, *Pakistan's 77th Independence Day* event was held at the Learning Center. Students participated in a quiz competition on the topic of "*Importance of an Independence Day*", students sang national songs and made different patriotic drawings. A cake specially prepared for the occasion was cut, which later all the students and staff enjoyed eating together.



#### **SEPTEMBER**



Class tests for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Term for the students at the SKRSF Learning center started from **August** 31<sup>st</sup> to September 13<sup>th</sup>. The test covered what the children had learnt before the summer break. Result day was held once the test papers got completed. The children received their test results and teachers also held the parent teacher meeting to discuss the progress of their children. Mothers also received their monthly sanitary packs.



On September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2024, "SKF's 2nd Learning Center" for underprivileged out of school children was inaugurated in Peshawar, Pakistan.



The girls only, Peshawar Learning Center inauguration marked a significant milestone for Street Kids Funds, reflecting a commitment to provide a platform for underprivileged out of school children who because of their family's financial circumstances were unable to get the education they deserve!!







**September 16<sup>th</sup>**, Multan Learning Center students got back to their regular learning activities for the final term of 2024.

Street Kids Funds Multan & Peshawar Learning Center staff organized fun filled learning activities for the students. "*All About Colors*" on **September 20**<sup>th</sup>.





The students learned about the different colors and how combining colors creates a new color, and enjoyed making color handprints for the classroom activity board.

"TEACHERS DAY" was held on **October 5th, 2024,** at the Multan Learning Center. To show the appreciation for the hard work the staff teachers do all year around, the students made thank you cards for their teachers.



October 11<sup>th</sup>, Street Kids Funds Multan Learning Center students participated in an educational activity through their art drawings under the theme "Nature & Flora".







### **Annual Comprehensive Eye Screening**

Regular eye checkups for children plays a vital role in supporting academic success and overall well-being. As part of SKF's **Health Initiative Project**, on **October 21**<sup>st</sup> & **22**<sup>nd</sup> "Annual Comprehensive Eye Screening" for SKF students & staff was conducted at the clinic of Eye specialist Dr Nasir Mahmood.

Dr Mahmood talked about the importance of annual eye checkups and how to maintain good eye care. He conducted detailed eye examination, prepared reports for each of the students and recommended eyeglasses for those students who had vision issues.

On **23<sup>rd</sup> December** children at SKF's Multan Learning Center celebrated the last day for the academic year 2024. Learning Center was beautifully decorated by the staff, students received their result cards, and amongst the students who secured 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> position in their class received

medals and presents. All SKF children studying in other schools were also invited to come to SKF Learning Center and celebrate the year end event. Children played different games and had snacks to eat marking the end of the academic year 2024!



On **18th December** along with two of SKF's youngest volunteers, Board Member Fahad Aziz' visited the SKF Peshawar Learning Center.



Fahad was inspired to see first-hand how in a short duration of only 4 months since SKF Learning Center, Peshawar was inaugurated in September 2024, the difference it was making because of the dedication of the staff and the enthusiasm of the students. Fahad spent time with the students and talked to the staff. Later the two young SKF volunteers distributed the gifts which they had brought for the students.
